

let's **clear** the air

Greater Vancouver's air quality has improved in the last few years, thanks to you and the AirCare Program.

Our program is credited with removing a total of 708,582 tonnes of pollutants from the region's air shed in its first seven years of operation.

And effective September 5th, 2000, we will have some new tests that will make it possible for all of us to breathe a little easier.

All-Wheel Drive Dynamometer

For the first time, we will be able to conduct a driving test on all-wheel drive vehicles. Drivers will need to ensure that they enter the lane(s) to the left and look for the signage below.

Pressurized Gas Cap Test

Vehicles that are 1995 or older will receive a pressurized gas cap check, to ensure that vapours from the fuel tank are prevented from escaping into the atmosphere.

New Diesel-Powered Vehicle Test

The new Diesel Opacity Inspection in Lane 1 at all AirCare stations includes a test cycle that more accurately simulates real-world driving conditions, to give a more accurate picture of the vehicle's emission performance.

AirCare Standards Adjustment

Although more stringent than they have been, the new AirCare standards will still be less stringent than the standard your vehicle was originally designed to meet. Any vehicle operating correctly and at normal temperature should easily pass the new AirCare test.



If you have a diesel-powered vehicle, all-wheel vehicle or a vehicle with traction control—watch for these signs.
